Understand the Copyright Agreement with Your Publisher

What rights do I retain as a journal author*?

- the right to make copies (print or electronic) of the journal article for your own personal use, including for your own classroom teaching use;
- the right to make copies and distribute copies of the journal article (including via e-mail) to research colleagues, for personal use by such colleagues for scholarly purposes*;
- the right to post a pre-print version of the journal article on Internet websites including electronic pre-print servers, and to retain indefinitely such version on such servers or sites for scholarly purposes* (with some exceptions such as The Lancet and Cell Press. See also our information on [electronic preprints](#) for a more detailed discussion on these points)*;

Publisher copyright policies & self-archiving

These are the publisher's default policies. Individual journals may have special permissions, especially if they involve other organisations or have paid open access options. Always run a journal title or ISSN search to check.

Author's Pre-print:	✓ author can archive pre-print (ie pre-refereeing)
Author's Post-print:	✓ author can archive post-print (ie final draft post-refereeing)
Publisher's Version/PDF:	✗ author cannot archive publisher's version/PDF
General Conditions:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Voluntary deposit by author of pre-print allowed on Institutions open scholarly website and pre-print servers• Voluntary deposit by author of authors post-print allowed on institutions open scholarly website including Institutional Repository• Deposit due to Funding Body, Institutional and Governmental mandate only allowed where separate agreement between repository and publisher exists• Set statement to accompany deposit• Published source must be acknowledged• Must link to journal home page or articles' DOI• Publisher's version/PDF cannot be used• Articles in some journals can be made Open Access on payment of additional charge• NIH Authors articles will be submitted to PMC after 12 months• Authors who are required to deposit in subject repositories may also use Sponsorship Option• Pre-prints for 'The Lancet' cannot be archived

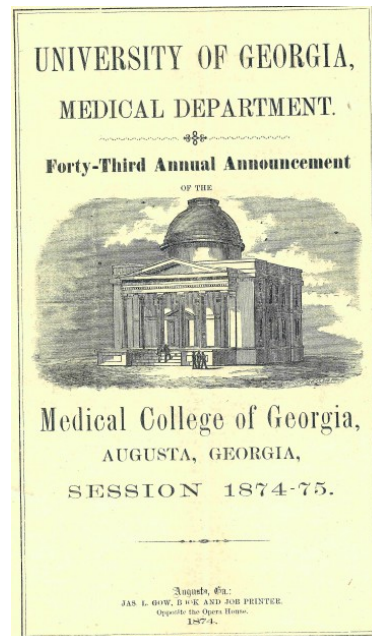
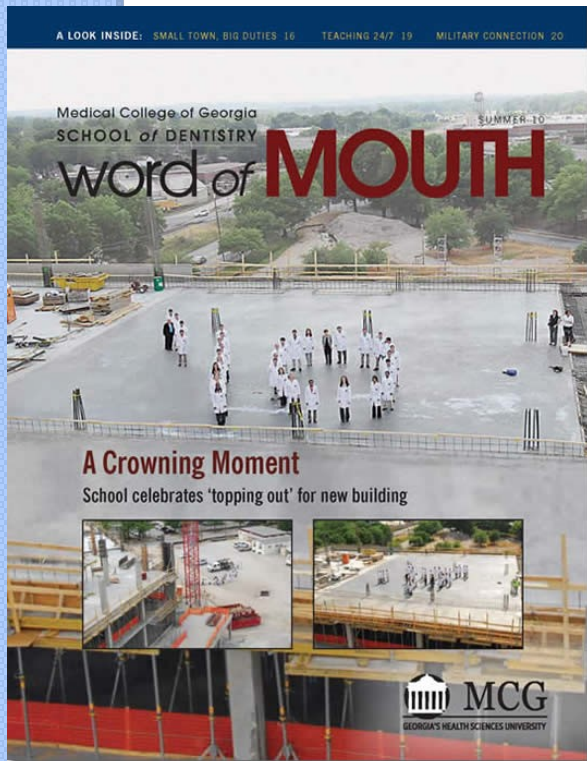
