Dr. Karp holds a PhD in Physiological Chemistry and held appointments in Augusta University's departments of Pediatrics, Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, Oral Biology and Maxillofacial Pathology, Oral Diagnosis and Patient Services and the Graduate School. He



is author of several hundred book chapters and peer reviewed articles in journals such as the American Journal of Medical Science, Journal of Pediatrics, Environmental Research, Biology of the Neonate and Clinical Dentistry. Dr. Karp is additionally a well known and beloved Jazz Musician in Augusta, who is passionate about the integration and importance of both the arts and sciences.
